## History

The Pikler Institute (nicknamed Lóczy from the street where it is located), was established in 1946 by pediatrician Dr. Emmi Pikler. The City of Budapest commissioned Dr. Pikler to organize a home for infants and young children who were deprived of their parents until satisfactory living arrangements could be found. Pikler's concepts and practices included ideas on respecting the child as a person – one who is considered an active individual, in a safe environment, and being allowed to move freely.

## Purpose

The success at Lóczy has been recognized by the World Health Organization, and the concepts and practices have been translated globally with the establishment of Pikler/Lóczy Associations in France, Switzerland, Germany, Austria, Spain, Italy, Holland, and Argentina.

The United States is home to a Pikler organization, *Resources for Infant Educators* (RIE). Based in Los Angeles and founded by Magda Gerber, a former Pikler associate, it offers classes and training in the RIE/Pikler approach. Pikler is fortunate to have the support of Tony Curtis and his daughters, Jamie Lee Curtis and Alexandra Sargent, who both have had first hand experience using the Pikler methods. Their contributions of time and effort are invaluable.

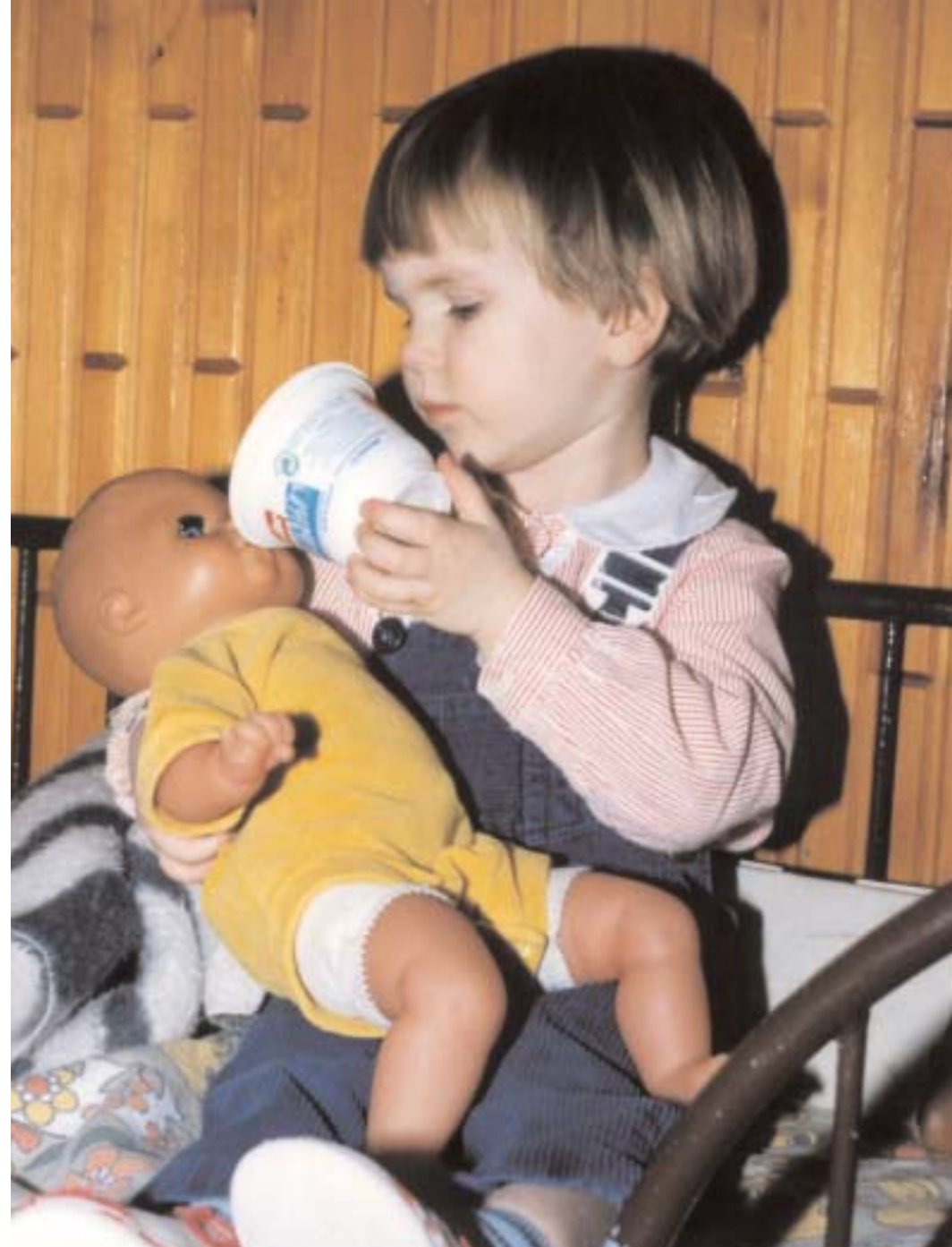
